<b>Enrolling Spouse</b>	Government Issued Marriage Certificate
<b>Enrolling Domestic Partner</b>	To enroll your Domestic Partner, please call Member Services for an application: 1-212-388-3500
<b>Enrolling Dependent Children</b>	
The Building Service 32BJ Health Fund permits you to cover a dependent child until the end of the calendar year in which he or she turns 19. However, if the child is a full-time student attending an accredited college, university, trade school or high school, coverage for such child may continue until the last day of the calendar year in which the child turns age 23 or the date he or she graduates or leaves school, whichever is earlier.	
<b><u>Relationship</u></b>	<b><u>Acceptable Supporting Documentation to Enrollment Form</u></b>
<b>Enrolling Biological Child</b>	Biological Child's Birth Certificate
<b>Enrolling Step Child</b>	Step Child's Birth Certificate AND Member's Marriage Certificate
<b>Enrolling Adoptive Child</b>	Adoptive Child's Birth Certificate AND Court Certified Order of Adoption OR Proof that such Petition has been filed with the Court
<b>Enrolling Grandchild, Niece or Nephew</b>	Court Certified Letters of Legal Guardianship OR Legal Custody Order OR Proof that such Petition has been filed with the Court. If Court Letters do not establish dependent's relationship to the member additional documents establishing such relationship will be required.
<b>Enrolling Child over age 19</b>	Student's Birth Certificate AND Student Certification Form
<b>Enrolling Disabled Child over age 19</b>	Proof of Total and Permanent Disability within 60 days of the date the child would have lost eligibility. Other restrictions apply. Contact Member Services at 212-388-3500 for a full explanation.
